Pastor's Message

Greetings!

Welcome to Lent! Lent is one of our favorite times in the church year leading up to the greatest day ever for us, Easter! First things first, Lent.

Lent is a forty-day period that begins Ash Wednesday, February 14th and ends on Saturday, Easter weekend. The word "Lent" means "Spring", which might be hard to imagine with such an early start date. I've always preferred a later Lent because the weather tends to be more in line with spring.

Lent is a time to prepare our hearts for the resurrection of Jesus on Easter Sunday. It is traditionally a time when we devote more of our time and resources to our faith journey through extra opportunities to gather for fellowship, worship, prayer, and giving. This year will be no different with the addition of our mid-week Holden Evening Prayer services and soup suppers.

Lent begins with Ash Wednesday which is all about our sin and mortality and need for a Savior. We can have ashes placed on our foreheads and be told to "remember we are dust and to dust we shall return." This reminder of who we are is meant to move us to Jesus, who promises forgiveness, life, and salvation. Ash Wednesday has readings that encourage us to practice our faith so that we have a closer relationship with God.

We will have five Wednesday services following Ash Wednesday until we reach Holy Week which I'll touch on more next month. For the five weeks our theme will be "Holy Lament" in which we will explore the various kinds of lament that are found in scripture. Each week will have a focus: What Is Lament; "Little" Laments; Laments from the depths; Individual Lament; Communal Lament.
